Public Park Fukada-Koen


Typical secondary forest, artificial wetland and habitat. Enjoy lunch!

Tropical Rain Forest


Diverse trees, mammals, insects and resinated Rafflesia flower obtained from Sabah, Malaysia.

The Aquatic World


Fish models and beautiful photographs invite you to the world of the natural river ecosystem in Hyogo.

4th Floor


Hitohaku Salon
